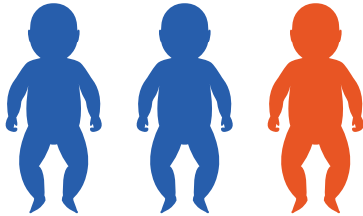
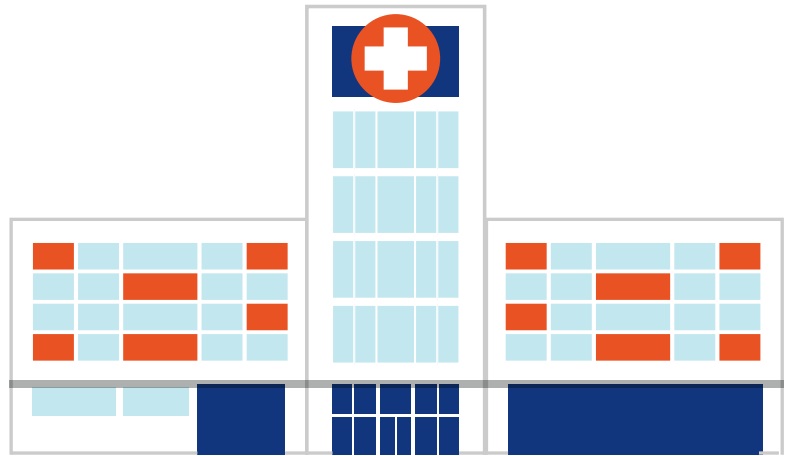


DIPHTHERIA, TETANUS, ACELLULAR PERTUSSIS (DTaP) VACCINE

WHOOPING COUGH (PERTUSSIS) IS **VERY CONTAGIOUS.**



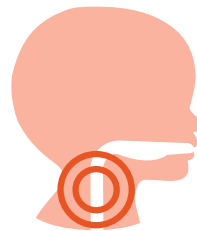
ABOUT ONE THIRD

Lockjaw

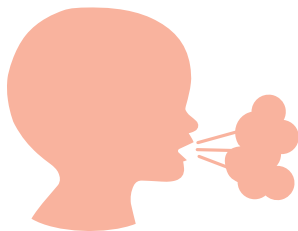
- Severe muscle stiffness
- Difficulty opening mouth, swallowing, and breathing
- Death

Serious Throat Infection

- Breathing problems
- Paralysis
- Heart failure
- Death



PERTUSSIS

Whooping Cough

- **Harsh cough:** The cough of pertussis—also called the “100-day cough”—may not go away for months. The cough can return with future illnesses.
- **Breathing problems:** Babies may not cough at all. Instead, they may struggle to breathe.
- Death
